Texas Children's Hospital The Woodlands is the first freestanding pediatric hospital dedicated to the communities north of Houston.

In the past, Texas Children's Hospital handled patients in North Harris County and Montgomery County through its Woodlands Health Center and in partnership with CHI St. Luke's Health.

However, if patients required specialty treatments, they had to travel 37 miles south to Texas Children's Hospital's Texas Medical Center location. TCH's Woodlands location was built to eliminate the nearly 80-mile round-trip trek, as well as to serve the existing and future population of the area.

The 22-acre campus includes a 350,000-square-foot hospital that provides a full range of services, such as emergency care, radiology, surgery, intensive care, neonatal intensive care and acute care inpatient services. The hospital includes 25 ER rooms, 28 critical care rooms, 32 inpatient rooms, four operating rooms and 12 radiology suites. The campus also has a helipad for emergency transportation. It is the only medical facility in north Houston staffed 24 hours a day, seven days a week with dedicated emergency medicine pediatricians.
